This family resource center will be a vital hub for Dakota County families, providing them with the support they need to help their loved ones while healing themselves. Through this initiative, Thrive will continue its mission to bring hope, help, and healing to families impacted by the opioid crisis. The services will be provided in the following ways: one-on-one support, family support groups, resource navigation, drop-in services and harm reduction supplies.
