Ordinance 113 Purpose



- "The purpose of this ordinance is to establish minimum requirements for regulation of SSTS for the
 treatment and dispersal of sewage within the applicable jurisdiction of the county to protect public
 health and safety, groundwater quality, and to prevent or eliminate the development of public
 nuisances. It is intended to serve the best interest of the county's citizens by protecting its health,
 safety, general welfare and natural resources."
- The ordinance requires variance requests to be approved by the County Board


New Septic System Setbacks:

Structures: 20 Feet

Private Wells: 50 Feet

Lake Byllesby: 75 Feet
